Sparkling Wines

“J”, *Jordan Sparkling Brut* (Sonoma)

The flavor profile begins with fresh apples and grapes, followed by a bright citrus core. The wine's medium acidity serves to marry all the components into a seamless experience, ending bright, juicy and long, with a toasted hazelnut and apple finish.

Brut, *Korbel* (Sonoma)

Light and crisp, with spicy fruit flavors. Balanced medium-dry finish. Korbel Brut is perfect for every celebration and many main dishes. Great served with many fruits and milder cheeses!

Gran Spumante, *Ballatore*

Inviting aromas reminiscent of ripe peaches and apricots combine to form a delightfully complex bouquet. Well-balanced and rich in varietal character with melony flavors and a crisp, clean finish.

Spumante, *Reiém* (Single serving)

This champagne is a straw color and a forward fruit flavor and mild floral character. The aromas of peach and lychee are balanced with a bouquet of toasty yeast notes and floral nuances. This Spumante is sweet, with outstanding fruit flavors, and a long, smooth finish berry fruits, framed by dark chocolate notes, mint and hints of vanilla. A lush, well-balanced wine whose ripe fruit flavors follow through on the palat

Red Wines

Pinot Noir, *Hob Nob* (France)

Strawberry and raspberry flavors; some spice but mostly fresh fruit. Easy drinking, well balanced for lighter fare.

Pinot Noir, *Pepperwood Grove* (CA)

An elegant wine with rich, spicy flavors with a smooth, clean finish.

Pinot Noir, *La Crema* (California)

Exotic flavors of strawberry tart, raspberry, and cherry cola are balanced by a creamy mid-palate and lingering finish.

Chianti, *Melini Borghi D' Elsa* (Italy)

Bright, ruby red. The bouquet is intense, fragrant with elegant scents of iris and raspberries and spices. The taste is dry, full and harmonious with an elegant aftertaste of toasted almonds and fruit.

Malbec, *Santa Julia Organic* (Argentina)

Spicy white pepper and blueberry cassis aroma with hints of chocolate and vanilla. Fine sweet tannins and spicy fruit flavors give the wine persistence and finesse.

Shiraz, *Yellow Tail Reserve* (Australia)

Aromas of ripe cherries, blackberries, chocolate and mocha. The palate is crammed with concentrated fruit.

Shiraz, *Tintara* (Australia)

Tobacco and lather give this an earthy taste with good structure and loads of dark berry fruit.

Shiraz, *Coppola* (California)

Very deep ruby with purple rim. A big mouthful of smooth, ripe and sweet fruit, balanced ripe tannins and good underlying acidity.

White Wines

Sauvignon Blanc, Glazebrook (New Zealand)

A refreshing fruit driven wine, full-bodied with intense flavors typical of Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc. A clean crisp finish with the classic Marlborough herbal edge.

Pinot Grigio/Chardonnay, Le Rime (Italy)

A light, refreshing wine with a clean and crisp finish. Flavors of fresh melons and berries appear throughout the finish.

Riesling, Jekel (Monterey County)

Freshly cut apple, apricot, lime, and honeysuckle blossoms combine to provide a charming bouquet. Bright, crisp acidity balanced with just a touch of sweetness make this wine a perfect companion to a wide range of foods.

Piesporter Michelsberg Spatlese, St. Christina (Germany)

The crisp citrus flavors match well with richer, more flavorful foods, or by themselves.

Freakout White Blend, Luna (Napa)

White blend of grapes with a lush ripe peach flavor and an intense that lingers.

Chardonnay, Kunde Estate (Sonoma)

Delightful floral aromas, bright lemon-drop acidity, and a rich, concentrated palate loaded with fruit. The lingering tastes of butterscotch, caramel and vanilla underscore but do not overwhelm the essential Chardonnay character.

Chardonnay, Jordan (Russian River Valley)

This wine is rich and vibrant with flavors that include fresh apple, pear and citrus, balanced with honey and a moderate amount of toasty oak and creamy character.

Chardonnay, Kendall Jackson (California)

Forward fruit flavors and aromas of peach, green apple, melon and tropical fruit are layered with butterscotch and oak. Lush and rich with balanced acidity.

Red Wines

Merlot, Red Rock (California)

Full-flavored, with ripe, enticing aromas of red and black berry fruits, framed by dark chocolate notes, mint and hints of vanilla. A lush, well-balanced wine whose ripe fruit flavors follow through on the palate.

Merlot, Chateau St. Jean (Sonoma County)

Fresh, intense plum and cherry vanilla aromas with a full, round, ripe berry flavor accompanied by a rather soft, spicy finish.

Merlot, 14 Hands (Washington)

Classic Washington Merlot flavors of blackberry and spice enhanced by a splash of Cabernet Sauvignon for structure and complexity. Velvety finish!

Merlot, Blackstone (California)

Dusty cherry flavors that lead to a clove and dried fruit finish. Cigar box flavors lead to dry finish

Mearitage, Kendall Jackson (CA)

Juicy, ripe tropical fruit like pineapple, as well as pear and apple. Creamy oak subtly creeps in, adding complexity to the mouth feel.

Zinfandel, Seghesio (Sonoma)

This wine combines spicy, lush, black fruit from Alexander Valley with cooler Dry Creek Valley fruit that provides structure, as well as Zinfandel's classic briary and raspberry flavors.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Stags' Leap (Napa Valley)

In the mouth, this wine is full and elegant. Supple and yet firm tannins. Prominent red fruit aromas threaded with sweet vanilla, cedar and the distinctive Stags' Leap briar aroma. Ripe cherry, currant and raspberry flavors blend with vanilla and cinnamon-clove spiciness.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Franciscan (Napa)

The ripe black cherry fruit that is highlighted by cocoa on the back palate. Rich and dense followed by a long fruit & spice finish.

Pinot Grigio, Santi Sortesele (Italy)

Bright straw yellow, elegant, dry and exotic fruits, excellent match seafood, salads, or all by itself!

Blush Wines

White Zinfandel, Beringer (California)

Fresh flavors of strawberries, pears, honeysuckle and sweet citrus.

White Merlot, Beringer (California)

Balanced bright cherry fruit flavors and acidity give this wine a fresh, juicy quality that is very pleasing

Cabernet, Rodney Strong (Sonoma)

A bouquet of boysenberry and cherry candy character. There is a red cherry fruit flavor on the palate with a mouth filling complexity.

Claret, Francis Ford Coppola (California)

Aromas of toasty vanilla, sweet blackberries and spicy black pepper, followed by rich flavors of blueberry, clove and mint. The wine concludes with a supple yet structured finish.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Founders' Estate (CA)

From Beringer Vineyards. Distinct flavors and aromas of deep, dark fruit – blackberries/cassis – with subtle vanilla mocha notes and hints of spicy cinnamon and oak.
